

Need for SRHR Services in Pakistan




Acronym of CREATE




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Intent of CREATE Project

Highlights of the Outcomes

- Participants comfort level and knowledge level in addressing SRHR matters is enhanced after attaining the training regardless of their professional expertise.
- Community found the replicated sessions extremely useful and majority of them rated the sessions "excellent".

- The community found that the sessions help them
 - Gain language skills related to sensitive issues
 - Build positive relations with their children
 - Enhance comfort in initiating the conversation

Challenges

• Using the word "SEXUAL HEALTH" in our trainings.

• The community didn't use the facility of phone counseling.

• Dealing/addressing conservative issues

Way Forward

• The master trainers can directly serve as a member in AKHB'P.

• AKHB'P has planned similar ToTs in southern, northern, and central regions of Pakistan from 2016-2018.

• AKHB'P has started planning of initiating a helpline
